In the center of town, you can find Kochi Castle, which was built over 400 years ago and is one of the last 12 castles in Japan to still have its original main keep. Nearby is Sunday Market, which stretches 1 km with over 400 vendors and has been fueling the daily lives of locals for over 300 years.

In Kochi, varied seasonal fish and produce can be found year round. With representative seafond like katsup on tataki (seared bonito) and fresh sashimi, Kochi is said to be the most delicious region of Japan. It is also famous throughout the country for its friendly people who love to drink sake. There are always people enjoying delicious food and drink downtown until late hours of the night, so why not try out Kochi's nightlife?


